### IS THERE ANY PARKING SPACE?

Yes. Both the church and the reception venue offer ample parking spaces for guests. We kindly advise everyone to arrive early to secure a spot, as parking is on a first-come, first-served basis.

### DO YOU HAVE GIFT PREFERENCE?

### CAN I BRING PLUS 1 OR SUBSTITUTE?

To help us plan comfortably, we can only accommodate guests who are formally invited. If a plus one is included, it will be indicated on your invitation. Otherwise, we kindly ask that only the guests named on the invitation attend.

### ARE CHILDREN WELCOME?

While our celebration is primarily intended for adults, only invited children, as well as the children of our immediate family who are part of the wedding party, are most welcome to join us.

### CAN WE TAKE PHOTOS DURING THE WEDDING?

Yes, you may take photos and videos during the ceremony and reception. We kindly ask, however, that you do so without getting in the way of our official photographer and videographer, so they can capture every moment smoothly. Thank you for helping us preserve our memories beautifully.

### WHAT TIME SHOULD I ARRIVE?

Our wedding ceremony begins promptly at 4:00PM, but the entourage procession starts at 3:30PM. We kindly recommend arriving by 3:00PM to allow time for parking, seating, and getting settled so you can enjoy the full celebration from start to finish.

### WHEN IS THE BEST TIME TO LEAVE?

We would be truly grateful if you could stay and celebrate with us until the end of the program, as each part of the day has been thoughtfully prepared. If you must leave early, we kindly ask that you let us know so we can personally thank you before you go.
